

Family Policy School Year 2025-2026

We have adopted the following policies to ensure all families have an opportunity to be involved in their child's educational program.

- 1) Meredith K-12 School is a full-service school that supports the individual therapeutic and educational needs of each student in a safe and aesthetically pleasing environment. Together, with community, we are committed to fostering intellectual, social-emotional, and moral growth.
- Families are invited to attend our annual Title I meetings offered in the fall and spring semesters to receive information regarding the Title I Program, services, school wide plan, and family policy.
- 3) Families are invited to participate in annual IEP meetings that are arranged with flexibility to honor time commitments. These meetings provide opportunities for input into school programs, curriculum, assessments, and other programs that relate to the education of their child.
- 4) The school-family compact is used so that parents and guardians will share the responsibility to ensure that each student is empowered to achieve his or her fullest potential:
 - a) Homework responsibilities
 - b) Student responsibilities
 - c) Teacher responsibilities
